It is a garland of invocations and of praise taken from Holy Scripture and from the Liturgy, which opens the heart to adoration, thanksgiving and love for the three Divine Persons. It is a solemn echo of the "Holy, Holy, Holy," which the angels and saints sing in heaven; it fills the universe and finds a joyful resonance in the heart of man: "one unceasing hymn of praise to the Holy Trinity."

This chaplet is a prayer of the
Order of the Most Holy Trinity
and of the Captives.
When you recite this holy prayer, we ask you
to include in your intentions
the 350 million Christians who suffer
persecution around the world.
